


ENVIRONMENTAL FUN FAIR

- ...and more!












NORTH MENDOTA TRAIL

Join Dane County Parks and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources on July 14 at 3 p.m. for a **Ribbon Cutting Ceremony** to celebrate the opening of a new shared-use trail connection.

This nearly ½ mile of new trail through the park completes a 4-mile segment of the North Mendota Trail that connects the Village of Waunakee and the Town of Westport between the North Mendota Wildlife Area Prairie Unit and the North Mendota Natural Resource Area. Future phases will connect the trail to Mendota County Park and the City of Middleton.

Where: Governor Nelson State Park, 5140 Cty Hwy M, Waunakee.

Bring your bike and ride across the trail to celebrate!



LIMITED ACCESS ARCHERY PERMITS

Archers interested in applying for an opportunity to receive a 2022 Dane County Parks Archery Limited Access Permit may apply July 11 through August 15, 2022. The program provides opportunities for archers to hunt deer and fall turkey on specific county lands with the required Wisconsin DNR hunting licenses.






PADDLE ON THE SUGAR RIVER


